#### **General Information**

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DUO -Thailand Fellowship Programme aims to enhance a balanced mobility of students between Thailand and 30 ASEM member states in Europe<sup>1</sup> by supporting paired-based and two-way exchanges. In this respect, the programme requires that a PAIR (two persons) of students be exchanged in the framework of cooperative project/cooperation between higher education institutions in Thailand and in 30 ASEM member states in Europe.

Eligibility	Eligible universities for the DUO - Thailand Fellowship Programme should abide by the following obligations:
